

SPECIFICATION FOR THE USE OF HALODEC

HALODEC is a masonry stabiliser which in one operation acts as a combined sealer/binder. It can be used on most masonry surfaces prior to the application of BIOCHECK SP.

For specific details of application, coverage etc, refer to the technical data sheet.

1. Prepare surfaces with stiff bristle brush, scraper, water jetting or grit blasting as appropriate. Remove all loose, flaking paint.
2. Areas of moss, lichen and algae to be treated with one coat of LICHENITE in accordance with instructions.
3. Carry out all necessary structural repair work, re-render and re-point where necessary. Fill all large cracks and prepare surfaces in accordance with good trade practice.
4. Mask up woodwork etc adjacent to surfaces being treated. Masking tape must be removed before HALODEC becomes dry.
5. Apply one coat of HALODEC by brush to all surfaces to be treated. Shake container well before use.

DO NOT DILUTE.

DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER DECORATIVE PRODUCTS.

6. Surfaces requiring a second coat – allow a minimum of 24 hours between coats. Allow 24 hours before decorating.
7. Apply finishing coat or coats of BIOCHECK SP masonry paint to give a long lasting, algae resistant, decorative finish.

APPLICATION NOTES

Normally one coat will be sufficient to bind surfaces prior to decoration. Apply liberally, by brush, to suitably dry surfaces until suction is satisfied. A second coat may be require on exceptionally porous or chalky surfaces. Allow a minimum of 24 hours between coats.

DO NOT apply in wet or frosty conditions, or when there is a risk of same during drying time.

- AVAILABILITY:** Supplied in 5 litre tins.
- STORAGE:** Protect from frost. Store in original container in a dry location out of direct sunlight. HALODEC is classified as a flammable material, flash point of 32°C, keep away from naked flames.
- WORKING PRACTICE:** Clean brushes etc in white spirit. Growing plants and areas not requiring treatment must be protected during application. Remove splashes with white spirit. Do not use near fishponds.
